STANDING WITH OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN KENYA

Pray for Peace

Pray that opposing sides in the political conflict will meet with hearts seeking what's best for the people of Kenya. Pray that personal and political agendas will be put aside and that both sides will prioritize peaceful reconciliation. 1 Timothy 2:1-6.

Pray for Wisdom

Pray that God would turn hearts towards Him, and that He would give wisdom to leaders at the local, regional, and national levels as they seek solutions and support for a nation of hurting people. Proverbs 1:7.

Pray for Provision

Pray that the Lord would provide food and other daily necessities for those in need. The recent rioting and unrest has made the economic climate, which was already difficult, even more challenging. There are many food shortages happening across the nation. Many people are hungry and unable to find affordable food. Philippians 4:19-20.

Pray for Protection

Pray that in the midst of unrest, the Lord would protect the most vulnerable populations in Kenya. Children, women, the elderly, and the materially poor are at greater risk for danger and exploitation because of the current unrest. Psalm 91.

Pray for the Church

It's estimated that over 5 million people will lack access to food and water from March - June 2023 because of the severe drought happening in Kenya. The drought, combined with inflation and higher costs of living in Kenya's agricultural society, puts added pressure on every aspect of Kenya's society. Psalm 89:1-14.
